Modified Arts presents artists Saskia Jordá and Chris Oatey in the exhibition “Random Interference,” opening Aug. 17, 2012.

Phoenix-based Saskia Jordá is an interdisciplinary artist who works with materials such as yarn, felt, and fabric to construct detailed sculptures, wall works, and site-specific installations. Her work, both architectural and geographical, addresses issues of culture, displacement, and assimilation.

Los Angeles-based artist Chris Oatey's site-specific installations address architecture and spacial issues using texture, materials and contrast to render opposing elements, while his smaller scale sculptures present both common and abstract shapes that become detailed studies of objects and their internal construction.
